## KEEP YOUR INFORMATION SECURE

**No Emory employee, including IT, will ever ask for your password.** Anyone who does whether in person, via email, or over the phone is scamming you. Do not ever give your password to anyone.

**Phishing emails:** If an email seems suspicious, it probably is a scam. Scam emails will often give an incorrect address of a real organization such as [emory@google.com](mailto:emory@google.com).

**Suspicious links:** Examine the link in the email. When hovering your mouse over the link, the actual address appears. If it is a different site from what it claims, be wary – this is a red flag.

**Attachments:** Before clicking on any attachment, confirm the sender is known and trusted. More details at: [oxford.emory.edu/Phishing](http://oxford.emory.edu/Phishing)
